

Joint Activities

Choose or select workshops for a longer activity or use as taster workshops on their own!

Boogie Mites

Phonic or number workshops for children and parents 1 or 2 hours 3-7years

Green Themes

Creative arts using environmentally friendly materials- parents and carers of children of all ages

Story/number sacks

Story sacks aim to give parents a different way to tell stories. ESOL parents can make and use dual language story sacks. Story sacks can also be used for numeracy! Groups may want to carry on without tutor support after the course finishes.

Sessions from 2hrs - 10 hours

Adults or adults and children aged 3+

Creative Arts – workshops

Within this course we are able to offer flexible learning opportunities which can focus on all sorts of art. There are opportunities for short workshops to pick up seasonal themes such as Christmas; Easter; Spring; sessions of 1- 10 hours grandparents/parents/carers with children aged 3+

Mini-Dig – In touch with the past

Dig up the past with a real archaeologist. Make links with the past and discover lots of interesting things buried from the past!

A fun activity for parents and their children 7+

Mini beast explorers

Explore school grounds or local green space to find mini beasts. This includes a range of activities relevant to the age of the children and type of green space. Outdoor games adapted to the age of the children, and the type of site, will be played. Parents and carers and children 4 years+ 2-6 hours

Habitat explorers

Investigate the different habitats within the school grounds. This will include a range of activities and environmental games. Ideas for improving gardens and school grounds for wildlife will be discussed. 2hr workshops. Parents and carers and their children 4 years+

Family Computing

This activity aims to explore different aspects of computing (ICT) and suggest ways that parents/carers can improve their own computer skills while working with their children. Parent/carer and children 3 year + 2 - 10 hours

Understanding Behaviour 0-5 years

This course aims to increase parents' confidence and self-esteem, to provide parents with a basic knowledge of how to manage behaviour at home and to enable parents to try a number of strategies in dealing with difficult behaviours.

Parents/carers only 10 hours

(Available after Autumn Half term)

Keeping a Child Healthy and Safe

This course will help the parent/carer understand the many factors that contribute to keeping a child healthy and safe.

Parents/Carers of children 0-5 years- 10 hours

Healthy Eating

This course aims to help parents/carers understand some of the lifestyle factors, which affect health. Healthy and less healthy food choices will be identified and suggestions on how a child's diet may be improved. The benefits of regular exercise will be recognised and ways of increasing the physical activity of a child can be identified.

Parents/Carers of children 0-5 years- 10 hours

Also available as a joint family activity – 2-20 hours.

FLLN Progression: Keeping up with the Children / Joint Family Literacy/Language

The Role of Family Learning

This course will help parents/carers identify the importance of them being involved in their child's learning and how it can raise achievement of the child. Activities and techniques that can contribute to the child's learning will also be identified. In addition the adult will be able to evaluate their own learning and be supported to think of ways they may develop their own skills. Parents/Carers of children 0-5 years- 10 hours
